In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of said Town, qualified to vote in elections and in Town Affairs, to meet at the **Oakham Center School**, Deacon Allen Drive in said Oakham, on **Wednesday August 24, 2016 at 7:00 p.m.** then and there to act on the following articles:


Article 1: To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate an additional sum of money for Oakham's share of the Quabbin Regional School District budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2016, provided, however that such additional appropriation shall be contingent on the approval by the Town at an election of a Proposition 2 ½ levy limit override in accordance with M.G.L. c59 §21C(g); or take any action relative thereto.

Article 2: To see if the Town will vote to support exempting from the provisions of Proposition 2 ½ so called, the remaining amounts required to pay for the outstanding bond costs for Municipal Building Project, provided, however that in order for such amounts to be debt excluded, the question would need to be presented to and approval by the voters of the Town at an election in accordance with M.G.L. c59, §21C(k), or take any action relative thereto.


