To either of the Constables of the Town of OAKHAM in the county of Worcester, in the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of said Town, qualified to vote in elections and in Town Affairs, to meet at the *Oakham Center School*, on the 11th day of June 2018 at 7:00 p.m. then and there to act on the following articles:

- Article 1: To see if the Town will accept reports of Town Officers as printed in the Annual Town Report; or take any action relative thereto.
- Article 2: To see if the Town will vote to fix the salaries and compensation of all Elected Officers of the Town as provided for by Chapter 41 Section 108, of the General Laws of the Commonwealth; or take any action relative thereto.
- Article 3: To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Treasurer, with the approval of the Board of Selectmen, to borrow in anticipation of revenue for the twelve-month period beginning July 1, 2018, and to renew any note or notes as may be given for a period of less than one year; or take any action relative thereto.
- Article 4: To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Board of Selectmen to enter into agreements with the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Department of Transportation for the construction, reconstruction, and improvement of Town roads; or take any action relative thereto.
- Article 5: To see what compensation the Town will allow for men and equipment used in repairing highways and opening roads for enginemen and/or firemen employed for the purpose of fire protection and for police officers employed for the purpose of police protection, during the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2018; or take any action relative thereto.

Article 6: To see if the Town will vote to accept any sum of money received from the Commonwealth of Massachusetts pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 90 of the Massachusetts General Laws and authorize the Treasurer to expend such funds for the purposes authorized, including maintaining, repairing, improving and constructing ways, up to the reimbursable amount according to the provisions of said Chapter 90, said funds to be spent with the approval of the Board of Selectmen and Mass. Department of Transportation; or take any action relative thereto.

Article 7: To see if the Town will vote pursuant to G.L. c. 44 §53E½ as most recently amended, to establish annual expenditure limits for fiscal year 2019 for all revolving funds listed in Section (f) of the Revolving Fund bylaw, Chapter 23 of the General Bylaws, as set forth below:

or take any action relative thereto.

Article 8: To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Board of Selectmen to enter into an agreement to lease to purchase, and equip, a Police Cruiser, including all other incidental and related costs, for a period of time in excess of three years, with the funding for the first-year lease payment to be addressed in Article 9, or take any action relative thereto.

Article 9: To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer from available funds, and appropriate from Ambulance Receipts reserved for Appropriation a sum of money to defray charges and expenses of the Town for the Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2018; or take any action relative thereto.
